CALL FOR PAPERS

The IEEE International Midwest Symposium on Circuits and Systems (MWSCAS) is the longest running circuits and systems symposium sponsored by the IEEE. The 61st edition (MWSCAS 2018) will be held in Windsor, Canada.

MWSCAS 2018 will include oral and poster sessions, student paper contest, tutorials given by experts in circuits and systems topics, and special sessions.

Prospective authors are invited to submit a full paper (4 pages) describing original work. Only electronic submissions will be accepted through the [on-line submission system](#). Papers should follow the formatting instructions in the [authors kit](#). Papers will be accepted for either lecture or poster presentation. Both formats have the same value, and presentation method will be chosen for suitability. Students are encouraged to participate in the Best Student Paper Award contest. We also encourage submissions of proposals for [Tutorials](#), [Special Sessions](#), [M.Sc./Ph.D. Forum](#) and [Demos](#). Accepted papers will be published in the MWSCAS2018 Proceedings subject to advance registration of at least one of the authors at the author rate. All papers published in the MWSCAS2018 Proceedings will be submitted for inclusion into [IEEE Xplore](#).

About Windsor: Windsor is a city in Ontario and the southernmost city in Canada. It is on the southern shore of the Detroit River, directly across the river from Detroit, Michigan. Windsor is a major contributor to Canada's automotive industry and has a storied history and a diverse culture. Ouellette Avenue is the historic main commercial street in downtown Windsor. It runs north-south, perpendicular to the Detroit River, and divides the city into east and west sections.
